## Pattern #133 - Wisley Gardens

To quilters using this pattern: There are inadvertent errors on page 4 and page 6 in the original pattern. They have been fixed in all new printings of this pattern, but if you have the older version of this pattern, this is what you need to know:

page 4: changes in cutting sizes have been marked in pink:

*Lap Quílt:* 57 ½" x 72 ½"

There are a lot of pieces in this quilt: they're easy to sew together, but there is a lot of potential to mix up the pieces.

- 1. I highly recommend that you label each piece as you cut it. This will alleviate a lot of confusion and wasted time as you look for the correct piece.
- 2. I suggest that you cut the larger pieces first. For example, Fabric #1 has two pieces that are  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ ". Cut a  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " strip that is the width of the fabric, and cut the two  $9\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " pieces from this strip. You can then re-cut the remaining strip to a smaller size, and cut more pieces.
- 3. Please note: if you plan to miter the corners of the borders or binding, you will have to allow extra length



page 6 of piecing instructions: the correction is in pink:

Sew a  $(3 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ ") (5" x 9  $\frac{1}{2}$ ") Fabric #1 rectangle to the top......

6. Sew a (3 ½" x 6 ½") (5" x 9 ½") Fabric #1 rectangle to the top of a (1 ½" x 6 ½") (2" x 9 ½") Fabric #7 strip. Then sew a (4 ½") (6 ½") Fabric #2 square to the left hand side of this piece.
